INSTRUCTIONS FOR DATA COLLECTORS

Approach. Introduce yourself in a friendly way and invite participation.

From the next page going forward, you can turn the device to the participant to complete by themselves (if they are comfortable with the technology and you are comfortable with them using the device).

1. "Hello, we are gathering feedback about today's event."

2. "This involves asking you some questions now, and then [Organisation Name] will send you an invitation later by email to do a survey."

3. "Is this okay?"

If an email address is provided, please type it in and then read it back to the respondent to ensure it is correct.

Sampling. Instructions for staff using this form:

1. If you are collecting sign-ups for an event, please complete this form for each person signing up (unless things get very busy, in which case you should follow a set rule e.g. every 5th or 10th person for the busy period).

2. If you are circulating at an event, please systematically select respondents based on a set rule (e.g. every 5th person; or one person from each row for a seated event) depending on how much time you have and the number of respondents.

3. For seated respondents, try to get a range of seating locations represented (not just those sitting at the end)
